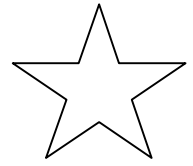


Points of Pride

- The students and staff supported the 4th annual charity basketball game between the 8th grade girls red team and the 8th grade boys white team and raised \$2,344.00 through staff, student and community donations to the Connersville Salvation Army to support the Lords Table.
- Students walked during their P.E./Health classes and collected an additional \$610.00 to donate to the Salvation Army.
- The CMS students raised a total of \$4925.00 during the 2014-15 school year that was donated to several charitable causes within the community.
- The CMS Choir performed the national anthem at an Indiana Pacers game in November and at the Indians game in May.
- The Male, Treble and Mixed Choirs competed at the Indiana State School Music Association in level I (the most difficult level for elementary/junior/middle school choirs) and all three choirs received gold ratings from all three judges.
- At the Music in the Parks competition at Kings Island, students from the combined choirs earned the highest superior rating placing first in the middle school/junior high category. The highlight of the year was the capturing of the coveted Esprit de Corps trophy - the highest award given.
- The CMS band was invited to perform at the Indiana Pacers in November.
- CMS 7th Grader students participated in the Reality Store for the 23rd straight year. The 7th graders get a reality-check by catching a

glimpse of everyday adult responsibilities such as budgeting and paying bills.

- A total of 100% of the 8th grade Algebra students passed the End of Course Assessment.
- 18 students who met the requirements for the "Advanced Reader" program read a total of 52,311 pages during the school year.
- The Social Studies academic team placed 3rd in the state overall in the Class I division and the Language Arts team placed 5th. The Science academic team placed 11th.
- The student athletic teams won 9 tournaments throughout the year to round out a very successful competitive season for all teams.
- The average GPA of student athletes demonstrated a strong commitment to achieving high academic standards. The average GPA for fall teams was 3.25, winter sports teams' was 3.26 and the spring teams average GPA was a 3.4. The combined overall average for CMS student athletes was a 3.3 GPA
